

Summary of the Indiana Sportsman Roundtable (ISR)

- Primarily goals are to provide an effective bi-directional education / communication forum for the organized sportsmen's groups as well as a lobbying organization for hunters, anglers, and other outdoor enthusiasts.
- Has held an alliance with the Indiana Wildlife Federation (IWF) for the last two years. The alliance is an arms-length relationship whereby
 - ISR pays IWF for use of their office for managing databases, email updates, and general communication.
 - While they share resources they are separate entities and have separate board of directors.
- The ISR is a conservation organization which strongly supports hunting and fishing, but not neglecting other conservation issues.
- Brief summary of goals (review ISR bylaws for a complete list of goals)
 - Provides a forum for groups who have an interest in outdoor sporting issues.
 - Promotes and encourages the scientific management based on sound biological principles, of the fish, game, forest and land resources of Indiana.
 - Educate members and the general public about improved educational, regulatory and legislative methods.
- Membership fee is \$150 for both the IWF and ISR (IAFS currently pays \$100 for IWF membership)
- Will hold quarterly meetings each year for all ISR member groups to discuss DNR policy and conservation legislation.
